





What3Words Quiz

What3words is a very useful website and app that splits the world into 3m by 3m squares and assigns each one a unique 3-word phrase to identify it, for instance you could describe the location of the county office as narrowest.against.busy. The emergency services recommend people download this app as it is very useful to locate someone who is stuck up a mountain or in the middle of the countryside.
