

Archery at the Jarman Centre INFORMATION AND BOOKING FORM for Residents and Day Visitors

The booking form should be sent with your main JC booking, or separately, to the JC Booking Secretary, (email as above, or call 01223 813917 for the address), together with the non-refundable deposit per session (which may be included in your cheque for your main booking deposit if applicable). We will acknowledge by email – and confirm also by email once an instructor has agreed to run the session. Please give as much notice as possible.

Group sizes

For ages 7-10, the group size will be up to 12 participants. Above age 10, group sizes may be up to 12 participants or between 13 and 18 participants. These numbers include adults and **cannot** be exceeded. Sessions for up to 12 participants will last 1 hour; sessions for 12 – 18 participants will last 1½ hours. Final payment will be due to the Jarman Centre, with the rest of your fees (if applicable) or separately, immediately after the session, to the Booking Secretary (as above).

If you wish to hire our equipment without one of our instructors, for use only at the Jarman Centre, this is charged per 1½ hours and a photocopy of your instructor's Archery GB certificate is required.

Likewise the bosses and safety net may be booked separately and a copy of your instructor's Archery GB certificate is required. Please note that with this option you must also make a residential/non-residential booking at the appropriate rate for your group.

Does your group require a second instructor?

For example, if they are at the bottom of the age range, several have special needs or for another reason need extra teaching or supervision. If you wish to discuss your requirements, or have a participant with special needs, please contact the Booking Secretary – we will make every effort to accommodate special needs (it is nearly always possible), but we need to know in advance as it may mean an extra instructor is required. There is no extra charge for this.

There must be an adult present with the group, who will be responsible for the behaviour of those waiting to take part and for First Aid. Adults can take part if they wish as long as the group size is not exceeded, but there must still be an adult to supervise those waiting to shoot.

You should keep a copy of this document for your own information. You MUST also read the risk assessment on the website before the session and note requirements for participants' clothing, long hair and footwear.

Please be aware that the archery range is outside and sessions can take place only in daylight.

Sessions can, however, take place when it is raining, and you should dress appropriately. In very adverse weather conditions the instructor will decide if the session can continue. Please note that if you cancel once the instructor has arrived you may be liable for a charge to meet expenses.

Sessions are normally available between 1 April and 30 October, but it may also be possible to book slightly earlier or later if enough notice is given.

IF YOU NEED TO CANCEL or change your session in advance, or for any other non-archery based queries (such as access), please email the Booking Secretary as above.

IF WE NEED TO CANCEL a session at the last moment for any reason we will contact you. We will always try to reschedule if possible.

The JC shop will be available to buy Jarman Centre Archery badges (£1.20 each). If you wish (especially if buying for your whole group), you may pre-order these to collect on the day and include payment with the balance of your fees.

There is a selection of other badges and souvenirs in the JC shop.

A note about late payments:

Full payment should be made within I week of your visit. The Jarman Centre reserves the right to charge 5% per month if the fee remains unpaid.
